## **RESOLUTION OF THE HAMMOND CITY COUNCIL**

A resolution (1) approving the submission of an application for a \$90,000 Affordable Housing Program grant to rehabilitate ten homes in Hammond; (2) agreeing to match these grant funds with up to \$10,000 in cash; and (3) authorizing the Mayor to sign all grant-related documents.

**WHEREAS**, the Affordable Housing Program (AHP), administered by the Federal Home Loan Bank of Dallas (FHLB Dallas) and member banks, seeks to develop and sustain affordable, owner-occupied housing for individuals and families of very low to moderate income;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hammond seeks to assist Hammond homeowners of very low to moderate income, who are aged 62 or older and/or who live with a disability, in rehabilitating their homes to improve the health and safety of Hammond's neighborhoods;

**WHEREAS**, the City is eligible to apply for \$90,000 in AHP grant funds to rehabilitate ten such homes in Hammond;

WHEREAS, the City is prepared to contribute up to \$10,000 in cash match to the project; and

**WHEREAS**, FHLB Dallas member bank Whitney Bank has agreed to partner with the City in supporting its AHP grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY

- 1. Approves the submission of an application for a \$90,000 Affordable Housing Program grant to rehabilitate ten homes in Hammond.
- 2. Agrees to match these grant funds with up to \$10,000 in cash.
- 3. Authorizes the Mayor to sign all grant-related documents.
