ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance to Amend the Code of Ordinances
Regarding Meetings of the City Council

WHEREAS, The City Council finds that a change to the existing ordinance on the dates in which regular meetings of the City Council are held is necessary to avoid conflicts with regular meetings of the Tangipahoa Parish School Board and that this revision will provide for the general welfare of the citizens of Hammond and to allow more opportunity for citizens to take part in both the political processes of City Council meetings and the Tangipahoa Parish School Board meetings and to revise the existing ordinance consistent with existing practice of the Council.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Hammond, Louisiana, that Chapter 2, Article II, Section 2-17 of the Hammond Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

+++++

Sec. 2-17. - Regular meetings.

(a) The regular meetings of the city council will be held on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month at the city council chambers beginning at 6:00 p.m., or at the conclusion of any scheduled public hearing on the same day.

(b) In the event a legal holiday occurs on a scheduled meeting of the council, then the regular meeting scheduled for that day will be held on another day of the same week as set by the presiding officer of the council.

2. All Ordinances in conflict therewith are repealed.
