RESOLUTION OF THE HAMMOND CITY COUNCIL

A resolution (1) approving an application to the Louisiana State Historic Preservation Office for a Historic Preservation Fund Grant of \$25,000 to renovate the Miller Memorial Library; and (2) supporting a cash match of \$25,000.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Historic Preservation Fund Grant Program, administered by the Louisiana State Historic Preservation Office (LASHPO), is to assist local municipalities in protecting their historic resources;

WHEREAS, each year, LASHPO sets aside a portion of Program funds to leverage projects that will rescue important and endangered historic buildings;

WHEREAS, the City of Hammond, through the Hammond Historic District Commission, may apply for a grant of up to \$25,000 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, both the City and the Commission desire to apply for a grant of \$25,000 to renovate the important and endangered historic building that is the Miller Memorial Library, and the City is prepared to match grant funds with \$25,000 in cash should the application be successful.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY

- 1. Approves an application to the Louisiana State Historic Preservation Office for a Historic Preservation Fund Grant of \$25,000 to renovate the Miller Memorial Library.
- 2. Supports a cash match of \$25,000.
