A resolution supporting the submission of a \$3,557 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant application to purchase radio equipment for the Hammond Police Department.

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (BJAG), as administered by the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice, is to provide criminal justice funding to units of State and local government to support a range of program areas, such as law enforcement, prosecution and adjudication, corrections and community service, technology improvements, crime prevention and education, planning and evaluation, victim and witness initiatives, and drug treatment and enforcement;

WHEREAS, the City of Hammond is eligible and has been pre-approved to submit an application for \$3,557 in law enforcement funding under the Fiscal Year 2017 BJAG; and

WHEREAS, in the interests of better equipping its police officers to respond to calls for service and improving communication between these officers and other law enforcement agency personnel and first responders, the City desires to apply to use these funds to purchase radio equipment for the Hammond Police Department.
