A resolution supporting the submission of a \$19,776 grant application to the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program to purchase radio equipment for the Hammond Police Department.

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, administered by the Bureau of Justice Assistance, is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to states and local units of government—providing additional personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support, training, technical assistance, and information systems for criminal justice, including law enforcement programs;

WHEREAS, the City has been allocated \$19,776 in FY20 JAG funds; and

WHEREAS, in the interests of better equipping its police officers to respond to calls for service and improving communication between these officers and other law enforcement agency personnel and first responders, the City intends to apply to use these funds to purchase radio equipment for the Hammond Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY

supports the submission of a \$19,776 grant application to the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program to purchase radio equipment for the Hammond Police Department.
